

The Rt. Rev. Kevin S. Brown, Bishop of the Episcopal Church in Delaware

Bishop Kevin Brown grew up in Asheville, North Carolina, and studied mathematics and psychology at Duke University. He completed his master of business administration at the University of West Florida while serving in the United States Air Force. He worked in finance and marketing at FedEx and helped launch an investment firm before earning his master of divinity from The General Theological Seminary in New York City. Before he was elected bishop of Delaware, he served as vicar and rector at Grace Episcopal Church in Paris, Tennessee, and as rector at the Episcopal Church of the Holy Comforter in Charlotte, North Carolina. Kevin was ordained and consecrated as the 11th bishop of Delaware on December 9, 2017.

As bishop, Kevin has sparked transformative evangelism initiatives diocesan-wide, formed the first-ever racial justice and reconciliation commission in the diocese, and continues to invest in the recruitment and development of lay leadership across Delaware parishes. He serves on the boards of The General Theological Seminary and Virginia Theological Seminary and is vice president of Province III of The Episcopal Church. He also serves on the boards of St. Andrew's Episcopal School and St. Anne's Episcopal School in Delaware.

Kevin and his wife, Caroline, an accomplished artist, live in Wilmington. He enjoys motorcycling and reading, though not at the same time.
